1 The elder to Gaius the beloved [one], whom I love in truth.  
 2 Beloved, I pray that you should prosper in all [things] and that [you] should be healthy, just as your soul is prospering.  
 3 For I rejoiced greatly when brothers were coming and were testifying to your truth, how you were walking in [the] truth.  
 4 I do not have greater joy than this, namely, that I should hear that my children are walking in [the] truth.  
 5 Beloved, you do faithfully whatever you do for the brothers and for strangers,  
 6 who testified to your love in the presence of [the] church, if [you] send<sup>1</sup> whom on their way worthily of God, you will do well,  
 7 for they went forth on behalf of his name, accepting nothing from the gentiles.  
 8 Therefore we ought to welcome such [men], with the result that we become fellow workers with the truth.  
 9 I wrote to the church; but he who loves to be first among them—Diotrephes—does not acknowledge us.  
 10 Because of this, if I should come, I will bring up his deeds which he is doing by talking nonsense about us with malicious words; and because [he] is not content with these [words], he does not welcome the brothers, and he hinders those who want [to welcome them] and throws [them] out of the church.  
 11 Beloved, do not imitate that which is evil, but that which is good; he who does good is from God, but he who does evil has not seen God.  
 12 It has been favorably testified of Demetrius by all [men] and by the truth itself; and we also testify favorably of [him], and you know that our testimony is true.  
 13 I had many [things] to write, but I do not want to write [them] to you with ink and pen;  
 14 but I hope to see you soon, and we will speak face to face<sup>2</sup>. Peace [be] to you. The friends greet you. Greet the friends by name.

1 The elder unto the wellbeloved Gaius, whom I love in the truth.  
 2 Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth.  
 3 For I rejoiced greatly, when the brethren came and testified of the truth that is in thee, even as thou walkest in the truth.  
 4 I have no greater joy than to hear that my children walk in truth.  
 5 Beloved, thou doest faithfully whatsoever thou doest to the brethren, and to strangers;  
 6 Which have borne witness of thy charity before the church: whom if thou bring forward on their journey after a godly sort, thou shalt do well:  
 7 Because that for his name's sake they went forth, taking nothing of the Gentiles.  
 8 We therefore ought to receive such, that we might be fellowhelpers to the truth.  
 9 I wrote unto the church: but Diotrephes, who loveth to have the preeminence among them, receiveth us not.  
 10 Wherefore, if I come, I will remember his deeds which he doeth, prating against us with malicious words: and not content therewith, neither doth he himself receive the brethren, and forbiddeth them that would, and casteth [them] out of the church.  
 11 Beloved, follow not that which is evil, but that which is good. He that doeth good is of God: but he that doeth evil hath not seen God.  
 12 Demetrius hath good report of all [men], and of the truth itself: yea, and we [also] bear record; and ye know that our record is true.  
 13 I had many things to write, but I will not with ink and pen write unto thee:  
 14 But I trust I shall shortly see thee, and we shall speak face to face. Peace [be] to thee. [Our] friends salute thee. Greet the friends by name.
