CHAPTER 1

1 In [the] beginning God created the heavens and the earth.  
 2 Now, the earth was formless<sup>1</sup> and empty<sup>2</sup>, and darkness [was] over the surface of [the] deep, and the Spirit of God was hovering over the surface of the waters.  
 3 Then God said, "Let there be light." And there was light.  
 4 And God saw the light, that [it was] good; and God separated the light from<sup>3</sup> the darkness.  
 5 And God called the light Day, and the darkness he called Night. And there was evening and there was morning, [the] first day.  
 6 Then God said, "Let there be an expanse in the midst of the waters, and let it be separating waters from<sup>4</sup> waters."  
 7 So God made the expanse and separated the<sup>5</sup> waters which [were] below the expanse from<sup>6</sup> the waters which [were] above the expanse; and it happened in this manner.  
 8 And God called the expanse Heavens. And there was evening and there was morning, [the] second day.  
 9 Then God said, "Let the waters below the heavens be gathered into one place, and let the dry land appear." And it happened in this manner.  
 10 And God called the dry land Earth, and the gathering of the waters he called Seas; and God saw that [it was] good.  
 11 Then God said, "Let the earth sprout grass<sup>7</sup>, herbs which yield seed, [and] trees of fruit which bear fruit whose seed [is] in them<sup>8</sup>, according to their kinds, upon the earth." And it happened in this manner.  
 12 So the earth brought forth grass<sup>9</sup>, herbs which yield seed according to their kinds, and trees which bear fruit whose seed [is] in them<sup>10</sup> according to their kinds; and God saw that [it was] good.  
 13 And there was evening and there was morning, [the] third day.  
 14 Then God said, "Let there be luminaries in the expanse of the heavens to separate the day from<sup>11</sup> the night, and let them be for signs and for seasons and for days and years,  
 15 "and let them be for luminaries in the expanse of the heavens to give light upon the earth." And it happened in this manner.  
 16 So God made the two great luminaries—the greater luminary for the rule of the day and the lesser luminary for the rule of the night—and the stars.  
 17 And God placed them in the expanse of the heavens to give light upon the earth,  
 18 and to rule over the day and over the night, and to separate the light from<sup>12</sup> the darkness; and God saw that [it was] good.  
 19 And there was evening and there was morning, [the] fourth day.  
 20 Then God said, "Let the waters swarm with swarms of living creatures, and let flying creatures fly above the earth upon the face of the expanse of the heavens."  
 21 So God created the great sea monsters and all of the living creatures which move, with which the waters swarmed, according to their kinds, and all winged flying creatures<sup>13</sup> according to their kinds; and God saw that [it was] good.  
 22 Then God blessed them, saying, "Be fruitful and multiply and fill the waters in the seas, and let the flying creatures multiply on the earth."  
 23 And there was evening and there was morning, [the] fifth day.  
 24 Then God said, "Let the earth bring forth living creatures according to their kinds: cattle and creeping things and beasts of [the] earth according to their kinds." And it happened in this manner.  
 25 So God made the beasts of the earth according to their kinds, and the cattle according to their kinds, and all of the creeping things of the ground according to their kinds; and God saw that [it was] good.  
 26 Then God said, "Let us make man in our image, according to our likeness; and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the flying creatures of the heavens, and over the cattle, and over all of the earth, and over all of the creeping things which creep upon the earth."  
 27 So God created man in his image; in the image of God he created him; male and female he created them.

CHAPTER 1

1 In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth.  
 2 And the earth was without form, and void; and darkness [was] upon the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God moved upon the face of the waters.  
 3 And God said, Let there be light: and there was light.  
 4 And God saw the light, that [it was] good: and God divided the light from the darkness.  
 5 And God called the light Day, and the darkness he called Night. And the evening and the morning were the first day.  
 6 And God said, Let there be a firmament in the midst of the waters, and let it divide the waters from the waters.  
 7 And God made the firmament, and divided the waters which [were] under the firmament from the waters which [were] above the firmament: and it was so.  
 8 And God called the firmament Heaven. And the evening and the morning were the second day.  
 9 And God said, Let the waters under the heaven be gathered together unto one place, and let the dry [land] appear: and it was so.  
 10 And God called the dry [land] Earth; and the gathering together of the waters called he Seas: and God saw that [it was] good.  
 11 And God said, Let the earth bring forth grass, the herb yielding seed, [and] the fruit tree yielding fruit after his kind, whose seed [is] in itself, upon the earth: and it was so.  
 12 And the earth brought forth grass, [and] herb yielding seed after his kind, and the tree yielding fruit, whose seed [was] in itself, after his kind: and God saw that [it was] good.  
 13 And the evening and the morning were the third day.  
 14 And God said, Let there be lights in the firmament of the heaven to divide the day from the night; and let them be for signs, and for seasons, and for days, and years:  
 15 And let them be for lights in the firmament of the heaven to give light upon the earth: and it was so.  
 16 And God made two great lights; the greater light to rule the day, and the lesser light to rule the night: [he made] the stars also.  
 17 And God set them in the firmament of the heaven to give light upon the earth,  
 18 And to rule over the day and over the night, and to divide the light from the darkness: and God saw that [it was] good.  
 19 And the evening and the morning were the fourth day.  
 20 And God said, Let the waters bring forth abundantly the moving creature that hath life, and fowl [that] may fly above the earth in the open firmament of heaven.  
 21 And God created great whales, and every living creature that moveth, which the waters brought forth abundantly, after their kind, and every winged fowl after his kind: and God saw that [it was] good.  
 22 And God blessed them, saying, Be fruitful, and multiply, and fill the waters in the seas, and let fowl multiply in the earth.  
 23 And the evening and the morning were the fifth day.  
 24 And God said, Let the earth bring forth the living creature after his kind, cattle, and creeping thing, and beast of the earth after his kind: and it was so.  
 25 And God made the beast of the earth after his kind, and cattle after their kind, and every thing that creepeth upon the earth after his kind: and God saw that [it was] good.  
 26 And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness: and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth.  
 27 So God created man in his [own] image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them.
